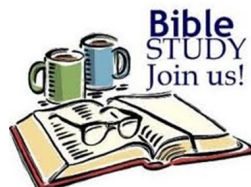

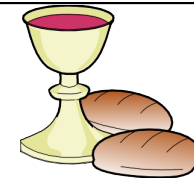
Minster passes
