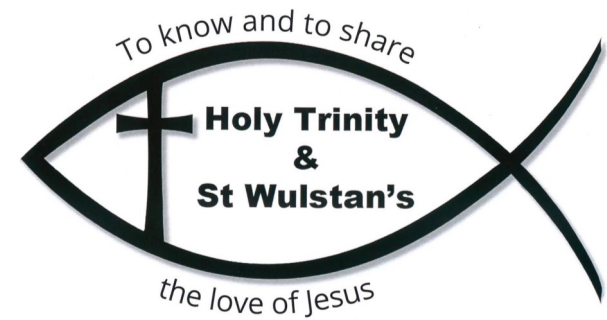

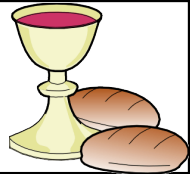
## Licensing of Canon Suzanne Sheriff
